a) Main objectives

Overall objective:

Improve the quality of life and the health of local populations in the targeted countries by strengthening actions to prevent and manage diabetes by mobilizing, training and consolidating a network of Civil Society Organizations (CSOs): associations of people with diabetes, health professionals, community.

Specific objectives (SO):

SO 1: Strengthen the capacities of targeted CSOs so that they can develop, implement and evaluate prevention and support actions for the diabetes care system in 3 countries (Burkina Faso, Mali, Senegal).

SO 2: Develop transversal capitalization actions then awareness, external communication and advocacy from the methodologies developed and the results obtained in 4 countries (Burkina Faso, Mali, Senegal and Union of the Comoros).

SO 3: Strengthen the structural and operational capacities of the Santé Diabète (Diabetes Health) association.

b) Expected results - detailed for each objective

SO 1:

- The capacities of CSOs to define their roles in the diabetes prevention and care system in 3 countries and to establish their action plans and intervention methods are strengthened.
- Diabetes actions led by CSOs from 3 countries are carried out
- Actions to support the diabetes management system led by CSOs in each country are carried out

SO 2:

- The methodologies developed and the results obtained are shared thanks to the networking of the different CSOs in the 4 countries
- Capitalization of good practices, results obtained and methodologies developed by local associations, local authorities and the NGO Santé Diabète is carried out
- The various tools resulting from the capitalization work are produced and disseminated through external communication, awareness-raising and advocacy actions

SO 3:

- The organization of the management pole (volunteers and employees) as well as country delegations is strengthened
- Internal communication between the salaried teams of the different delegations is reinforced

a) Main objectives

Overall objective : Improve the quality of care and the care of patients with co-morbidity (diabetes / HIV, diabetes / TB) by strengthening the political frameworks and by training diabetes staff in HIV and TB and HIV and TB diabetes advisers in Burkina Faso and Mali.

Specific objectives (SO):

SO 1 : Strengthen the standards and procedures of national policy documents relating to the 3 pathologies in the two countries as well as the operational documents which result therefrom by integrating the prevention and management of cases of Diabetes / TB and Diabetes / HIV co-pathologies

SO 2 : Strengthen the curricula of two diplomas (DES endocrinology, metabolic diseases and nutrition and DU diabetology) by integrating the care and therapeutic education of patients with bi pathology (Diabetes / TB or Diabetes / HIV)

SO 3 : Reinforce the level of skills, for the care and therapeutic education of patients with a bi pathology (Diabetes / TB or Diabetes / HIV), of 384 health professionals (192 doctors and 192 nurses practicing in the structures of 3rd and 2nd Burkina Faso and Mali reference)

SO 4 : Strengthen the skills level of 9 community networks in order to ensure pilot targeted prevention actions for PLWHA, people with diabetes and Tuberculosis in Burkina Faso and Mali

SO 5 : Develop monitoring committees within the countries and between the two countries to promote transversal capitalization and external communication actions based on the methodologies developed and the results obtained in Burkina Faso and Mali

b) Results and Activities

SO 1 : The standards and procedures of the national policy documents affecting the 3 pathologies in the two countries as well as the operational documents which result therefrom

are reinforced by integrating the prevention and management of cases of co-pathologies Diabetes / HIV and Diabetes / TB

SO 2 : The skill level of 50 students specializing in medicine (endocrinology, internal medicine and infectious diseases) for the care and therapeutic education of patients with dual pathology (Diabetes / TB or Diabetes / HIV) is reinforced

SO 3: The level of skills, for the care and therapeutic education of patients with bi pathology (Diabetes / TB or Diabetes / HIV), of 384 health professionals (192 doctors and 192 nurses practicing in the structures of 3rd and 2nd Burkina Faso and Mali) is reinforced

SO 4: The skill level of 9 community networks to ensure pilot targeted prevention actions for PLWHA, people with diabetes and Tuberculosis in Burkina Faso and Mali is reinforced

SO 5: Monitoring committees within the countries but also between the two countries to promote transversal capitalization and external communication actions based on the methodologies developed and the results obtained in Burkina Faso and Mali are developed and functional

a) Main objectives

Overall objective : Build capacity at the political level and at the level of the health system in order to strengthen the prevention and management of diabetes in Mali and its co-infections.

Specific objectives (SO):

SO 1: Strengthening national strategies dedicated to the fight against diabetes

SO 2: Strengthening the health system for diabetes care

b) Results and Activities

SO 1: Best NCD policy for the Republic of Mali and a specific diabetes health policy that includes all strategic frameworks, standards and procedures. Also, the other documents on health policies linked to diabetes (maternal, child health, HIV, tuberculosis, nutrition) will be strengthened by including standards on diabetes.

SO 2:

- Strengthen decentralization of diabetes care
- Availability of trained specialists in all 3rd reference structures and in 75% of decentralized consultations
- Implementation of 200 diabetes-related consultations in primary care centers across the country.
- Training in the co-management of HIV diabetes and diabetes / tuberculosis for 50% of reference doctors in these 3 pathologies (90 doctors)
- Availability of files and medical data of all people with diabetes, in electronic form and monitored by the Malian health system
- Organization of 75 screening sessions
- Training received on gestational diabetes for 300 health professionals in 4 regions of Mali
